








## Kyiv sightseeing tour

### ITINERARI

- **The Golden Gates** – in the 11th century, Kyiv was a fenced city. A person could enter the city through one of three grand gates. The Golden Gates were a ceremonial entrance way, opened only for important guests.
- **The Opera House** – one of the most notable ballets and opera stages in Europe, which will amaze you with its elegance, gravity and luxury.
- **St. Sophia Cathedral** – the oldest building in the city and the oldest Christian temple on the lands of the East Slavs to have survived to the present day.
- **Kontraktova square** is located in the Lower Town (Podil District) and is one of the oldest squares in Kyiv, known from the times of Kievan Rus. This is an interesting place to feel the spirit of ancient Kyiv. The main building of the National University of Kyiv-Mohyla Academy (KMA), the fountain/ sculpture of Samson, the bell tower of Saint Katerina Greek monastery, the monument to Petro Sahaydachniy, the House of Contracts are all located there.
- **Funicular** has transformed from needed public transport into a real pride of the capital.
- **Khreshchatyk street and Maidan** – is the heart of Kyiv and must-stop for all visitors of the city. Maidan or the Independence Square is a place for demonstrations and revolutions.
- **“Arsenalna” metro station** is currently the deepest station in the world (105.5 metres (346 ft)).
- **“Mother Motherland Monument”** is a part of the Museum of WWII complex. A massive female warrior stands guard over Kyiv.
- **Cave monastery – Kyiv Pechersk Lavra** is one of the first Orthodox Christian monasteries in Kievan Rus included in the World Heritage List of UNESCO.
